Job Summary

Reporting to ICT RN Coordinator – Maternal Child Health, the Family Visitor is responsible for conducting home visits to families with children aged 0-6 years of age to identify health needs of the family; establishes resource needs & linkages required to support family health requirements; follows all OHA policies, procedures & strengthening families program standards; works in a multidisciplinary team & may be called upon to assist with other duties within the scope of the department.

- Grade 12 or GED equivalent
- Education related to child development (preferred)
- Certificate First Aid, CPR (preferred)
- Knowledge of Aboriginal health issues, community health programs/services, First Nations community
